

The 5 Basic Steps

- 1) Start with a high quality, scannable color artwork, ideally this would be a transparency, unscreened photo or other high quality image.
- 2) Scan images to be at least 400 pixels per inch for as many inches wide as the finished banner will be in feet. If the image has fine detail, scanning at a higher resolution will result in a better print.
- 3) Set up your document to be proportional to the final image. For example: if the final image is 20'x30' create a document that is 20"x30", 10"x15" or 24"x36", etc.
- 4) Assemble your layout as you normally would in your page layout application. When possible, use vector artwork for logos and keep from rasterizing text. This will result in a sharper image.
- 5) When your layout is finished, collect all of the layout elements (placed images, all fonts used in document, logos, etc.) and print out a hard copy of the layout. Send us the finished layout and the rest is up to us.

*Please Note: For twice the resolution double the resolution specified above.
